WHEREAS, The Harrison Company, Inc., a dissolved Colorado corporation, ("Assignor"), formerly located at 3131 South Vaughn Way, Suite 520, Aurora, Colorado 80014, and whose post office address is now 5333 Bannock Street, Denver, Colorado 80216, owns the entire right, title and interest in a certain new and useful invention relating to DATA PROCESSING TECHNIQUE FOR SCORING BANK CUSTOMER RELATIONSHIPS AND AWARDED INCENTIVE REWARDS, said ownership recorded at the U.S. Patent Office at Reel 5995, Frames 0788, 0795, 0801, 0808 and 0815; and for which an application for Letters Patent of the United States has been filed with the U.S. Patent Office and may be identified in the United States Patent Office as Application Serial No. 07/808,324, filed on December 16, 1991, entitled DATA PROCESSING TECHNIQUE FOR SCORING BANK CUSTOMER RELATIONSHIPS AND AWARDED INCENTIVE REWARDS, and

UPON SAID CONSIDERATION, the Assignor hereby covenants and agrees with the Assignee that the Assignor will not execute any writing or do any act whatsoever conflicting with these presents, and that the Assignor will, at any time upon request, without further or additional consideration, but at the expense of the said Assignee, execute such additional assignments and other writings and do such additional acts as said Assignee may deem necessary or desirable to perfect the Assignee's enjoyment of this grant, and render all necessary assistance in making application for and obtaining original, continuation, continuation-in-part, divisional, renewal, reissued or extended Letters Patent of the United

States, or of any and all foreign countries, on said invention, and in enforcing any rights or choses in action accruing as a result of such applications or patents, by giving testimony in any proceedings or transactions involving such applications or patents, and by executing preliminary statements and other affidavits, it being understood that the foregoing covenant and agreement shall bind, and inure to the benefit of, the assigns and legal representatives of both parties.

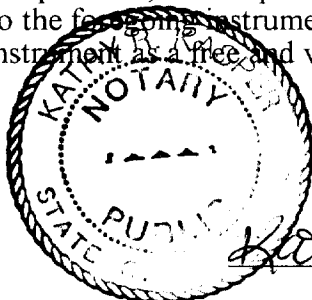
