**ASSIGNMENT**

WHEREAS, R. Mitchell Baldwin, II, residing at 254 College, S.E., Grand Rapids, Michigan 49503 (hereinafter referred to as "Assignor"), has invented certain new and useful improvements in HIGH IMPULSE CARDIOPULMONARY RESUSCITATOR for which an application for United States Letters Patent was executed on even date herewith.
