and in and to any and all patents of the United States and foreign countries which may be issued for said invention;

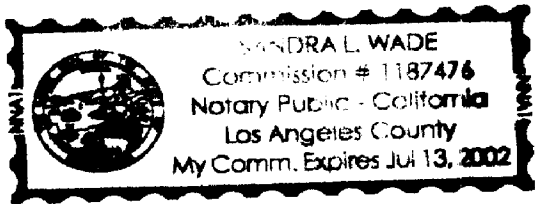

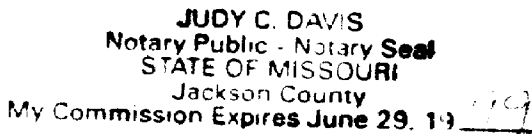
