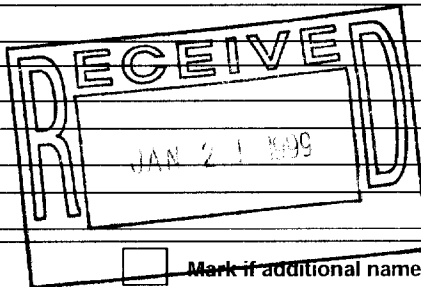

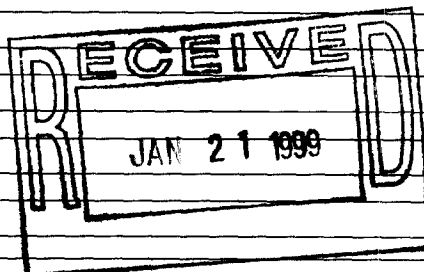

## PATENT ASSIGNMENT AGREEMENT

This Agreement is entered into this 21st day of August 1998 by and between: (1) John McEleney, Wende Buras (nee Reenstra) and Curtis A. Vock, all individuals residing in Massachusetts, and SeeUV, LLC, a Massachusetts limited liability company having a principal place of business in Charlestown, Massachusetts (hereinafter collectively referred to as "Sellers"); and (2) IPA, LLC, a Texas limited liability company having a principal place of business in Fort Worth, Texas (hereinafter referred to as "Purchaser").

WHEREAS, Sellers collectively own the entire right, title and interest to United States Patent Nos. 5,567,420 (hereinafter referred to as "the '420 Patent"); 5,680,962 (hereinafter referred to as "the '962 Patent"); 5,753,210 (hereinafter referred to as "the '210 Patent"); and related application for a patent Serial No. 09/024,458 (hereinafter referred to as "the '458 Application").

WHEREAS, Sellers desire to convey their ownership interests in the '420 Patent, the '962 Patent, the '210 Patent and the '458 Application to Purchaser, and Purchaser desires to acquire such ownership interests.

NOW, THEREFORE, Sellers and Purchaser agree and acknowledge that, for the payment of ten dollars (\$10.00) and other good and valuable consideration, as follows:

1. Sellers warrant that they are the sole and exclusive owners of the '420 Patent, the '962 Patent, the '210 Patent and the '458 Application, and that no assignment, license, sale, agreement or encumbrance as to the any of these patents or application for a patent has been or will be made with any other party.

2. Sellers hereby sell, assign and transfer to Purchaser the full, exclusive and entire right, title and interest to the '420 Patent, the '962 Patent, the '210 Patent the '458 Application and any extensions, renewals, divisions, continuations, reissues and reexaminations based in whole or part on the '420 Patent, the '962 Patent, the '210 Patent and/or the '458 Application, including the right to bring suit and collect damages for any infringements of the '420 Patent, the '962 Patent and/or the '210 Patent occurring before the date of this Agreement.

3. Sellers shall, at Purchaser's request, cooperate fully with Purchaser in the maintenance, enforcement or exploitation of the '420 Patent, the '962 Patent, the '210 Patent and the '458 Application, or any legal or administrative proceedings relating thereto, and shall execute all papers or testify in any proceedings necessary to preserve Purchaser's ownership interest in the '420 Patent, the '962 Patent, the '210 Patent and the '458 Application.

4. Sellers shall also furnish to Purchaser copies of any documentation in their possession, custody or control illustrating or describing the inventions of the '420 Patent, the '962 Patent, the '210 Patent and the '458 Application.


