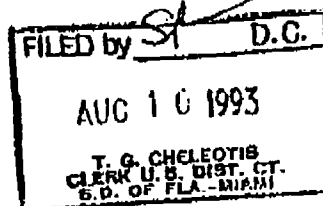

ORDER ON DEFAULT JUDGMENT

THIS CAUSE having come on to be heard upon Plaintiff's motion for default judgment against the Defendants Harold F. Hoppstadter and Coinex, Inc. (DE #50) The Court, having reviewed the record and being otherwise duly advised in the premises, it is hereby:


ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that a default judgment is entered against the Defendant Coinex, Inc. whereby that certain assignment of U.S. patent number 4,853,684 dated January 7, 1991 and recorded in the United States Patent Office and reel 5559, frame 674 is declared null and void and of no legal or equitable consequence in transferring any right, title or interest in said U.S. patent from Pascall Coinex Corporation to Coinex, Inc.

That the Defendant Coinex, Inc. is permanently enjoined from, directly or indirectly, using the trademark COINEX in connection with any business venture or endeavor and from claiming any

interest right or title in said trademark and/or the U.S. registration of said trademark, no. 1,416,478.

That a default judgment be entered against the Defendant Harold Hoppstadter whereby the Defendant Harold F. Hoppstadter is permanently enjoined from engaging, directly or indirectly, any business venture or endeavor involving remotely operated vending machines.
