WHEREAS, we the undersigned, **John R. 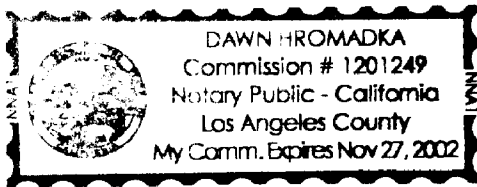
