ASSIGNMENT OF INVENTION

WHEREAS, Albert D. Edgar, residing at 3912 Eton Lane, Austin, Texas, 78727-6069 and Steven C. Penn, residing at 6005 Tonkowa Trail, Georgetown, Texas 78628 (hereinafter referred to as Assignors) have invented an invention disclosed in U.S. Patent Serial No. 06/073,602 and filed on February 4, 1998 and entitled:

MULTILINEAR ARRAY SENSOR WITH AN INFRARED LINE

for which application for Letters of Patent of the United States has been filed; and

Assignors hereby covenants that no assignment, sale, agreement, or encumbrance has been or will be made or entered into which would conflict with this assignment and sale, and that they have full right to convey the interest assigned herein.

Assignors further covenants that Assignee, will, upon its request, be provided promptly with all pertinent facts and documents relating to said application, said invention and said Letters Patent or legal equivalents as may be known and accessible to Assignors; Assignors will testify as to the same in any interference or litigation related thereto; and Assignors will promptly execute and deliver to Assignee or its legal representatives any and all papers, instruments or affidavits required to apply for, obtain, maintain and enforce said application, said invention and said Letters Patent and any patent or patent application thereon which may be granted or applied throughout the world which may be necessary or desirable to carry out the purposes hereof.

I hereby authorize and request the Commissioner of Patents and Trademarks to issue the said Letters Patent, when granted, to Assignee as owner of all my right, title, and interest in and to the same, for the sole use and enjoyment of Assignee and its successors and assigns.

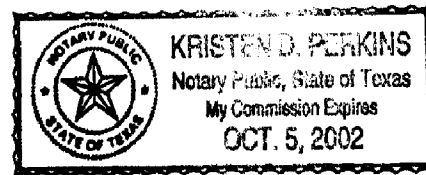
