ASSIGNMENT

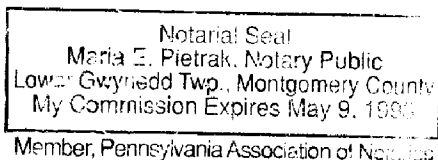
