CORRECTED PATENT ASSIGNMENT

WHEREAS, S. NOW, THEREFORE, TO ALL WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:



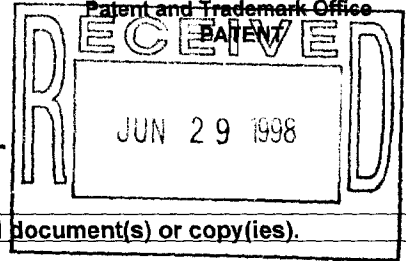


