



## ASSIGNMENT

Whereas we, Robert S. Ampulski of Cincinnati, Ohio, Vladimir Vitenberg of Cincinnati, Ohio, and Larry L. 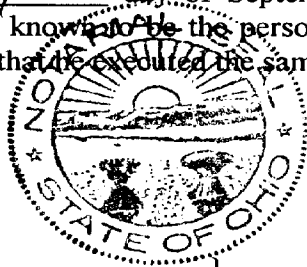
