WHEREAS, (1) MILOS SOVAK, of La Jolla, California; (2) ALLEN L. SELIGSON, of San Marcos, California; (3) JAMES GORDON DOUGLASS III, of San Diego, California; (4) BRIAN CAMPION, of Leucadia, California; and (5) JASON W. 


