ASSIGNMENT

WHEREAS, I, Toshio WADA, having an address c/o Nippon Foundry, Inc., 1580 Yamamoto, Tateyama-shi, Chiba, 294-8502, JAPAN, have made a certain new and useful invention relating to SEMICONDUCTOR MEMORY INTEGRATED CIRCUIT DEVICE for which I have made application for Letters Patent of the United States in an application to be filed concurrently herewith claiming priority of Japanese Application No. 10-044353 filed February 10, 1998, said application being designated U.S. Serial No. 09/241,748 and identified by Attorney Docket No. 38387.830009.000 in the law firm of Holland & Hart LLP, 555 Seventeenth Street, Suite 3200, Denver, Colorado 80202;

UPON SAID CONSIDERATION, I do hereby covenant and agree with said assignee that I will not execute any writing or do any act whatsoever conflicting with these presents, and that I will, at any time upon request, without further or additional consideration, but at the expense of the said assignee, execute such additional assignments and other writings and do such additional acts as said assignee may deem necessary or desirable to perfect the assignee's enjoyment of this grant, and render all necessary assistance in making application for and obtaining original, divisional, renewal, reissued or extended Letters Patent of the United States, or of any and all foreign countries, on said invention, and in enforcing any rights or chooses in action accruing as a result of such applications or patents, by giving testimony in any proceedings or transactions involving such applications or patents, and by executing preliminary statements and other affidavits, it being understood that the foregoing covenant and agreement shall bind, and inure to the benefit of my assigns and legal representatives.
