


WHEREAS, ACE ELECTRIC, INC., a corporation organized and existing under and by virtue of the laws of the State of Nevada and having a mailing address of P.O. 
ASSIGNOR hereby covenants that no assignment, sale, agreement or encumbrance has been or will be made or entered into which would conflict with this Assignment.
