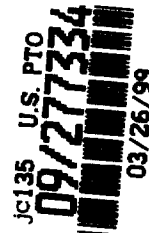

ASSIGNMENT

WHEREAS, WE, Robert W. McDowell, a U.S. citizen, residing at 12719 Calle De Las Rosas, San Diego, California 92129, and John M. Gray, a U.S. citizen, residing at 1233 Corte Cielo, San Marcos, California 92069, have invented certain new improvements in a **PRESSURE MANAGEMENT AND VAPOR RECOVERY SYSTEM FOR FILLING STATIONS**, for which we have executed an application for Letters Patent in the United States, specification of which is filed herewith.

AND WE HEREBY covenant and agree that we will communicate to the said Dover Corporation, its successors, legal representatives and assigns, any facts known to us respecting said improvements, and testify in any legal proceeding, sign all lawful papers, execute all divisional, continuing and reissue applications, make all rightful oaths and generally do everything possible to aid the said Dover Corporation, its successors, legal representatives and assigns, to obtain and enforce proper patent protection for said improvements in all countries.
