ASSIGNMENT

WHEREAS We, Duane Finello and Scott L. Roberson, while employed by the United States of America, made an invention entitled ALKALINE ELECTROCHEMICAL CAPACITOR AND ELECTRODE FABRICATION, described in an application for Letters Patent of the United States executed by us, on the 28th day of January, 1998, and the 28th day of January, 1998, respectively;

WHEREAS, the conditions under which said invention was made are such as to entitle the Government under paragraph 1(a) of Executive Order 10096, to the entire right, title and interest therein, including foreign rights; and

WHEREAS, as to such foreign rights, it is the policy of the Government to obtain an option to exercise such rights;


NOW, THEREFORE, to all whom it may concern, be it known that for and in consideration of the premises and other valuable considerations, We, Duane Finello and Scott L. Roberson, have sold, assigned, and transferred, and by these presents do sell, assign, and transfer unto the Government of the United States, as represented by the Secretary of the Air Force, the entire right, title and interest throughout the United States of America, its territories and dependencies, in and to the aforesaid joint invention described in the aforesaid application for Letters Patent of the United States, and all Letters Patent issuing thereon and any continuations, divisions, and reissues or extensions thereof; We hereby authorize and request the commissioner of Patents to issue said Letters Patent to the United States of America, as represented by the Secretary of the Air Force, and his successors, as assignee of the entire right, title and interest in and to the same throughout the United States of America, as its territories and dependencies, for the sole use for the full term or terms for which said Letters Patent and any continuations, divisions and reissues or extensions thereof are, or may be, granted as fully and entirely as the same would have been held by us, Duane Finello and Scott L. Roberson, had this Assignment not been made; and We do hereby also grant unto the United States of America as represented by the Secretary of the Air Force, the option to take all of the right, title and interest in our invention or all applications for Letters Patent thereon in all countries foreign to the United States in which the United States of America may file or cause to be filed, applications for Letters Patent, without payment to us of any further consideration; provided, however, that this grant of an option to take foreign rights in the invention must be exercised by written notice to us within 8 months of the filing date of any application for United States Letters Patent covering our invention, within eight months from the declassification of the joint invention, whichever is later, and that all foreign rights not exercised under the option are left to me subject to a nonexclusive, irrevocable, royalty-free license to the United States of America in any patent which may issue on said joint invention in any foreign country, including the power to issue sublicenses for use in behalf of the United States of America and/or in furtherance of the foreign policies of the United States of America; and we, Duane Finello and Scott L. Roberson, hereby agree to execute any and all applications for Letters Patent, and to furnish all data and documents and to execute any papers which may be necessary for the preparation or filing of such domestic applications, or for the Government to exercise its option granted hereunder, except it shall be understood that we shall not be subject to any out-of-pocket expense relative to such action.


