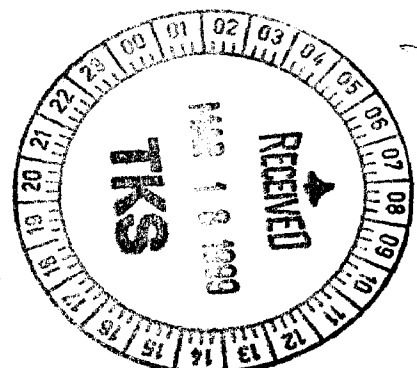
ORDER OF SUMMARY ADMINISTRATION


