- (i) in and to the Patents, for the territory of the United States and its possessions and territories, and in and to the Foreign Patent Application;
- (ii) in and to all United States and foreign divisions, reissues, reexamination certificates and continuations of the Patents and any patent issued in respect of the Foreign Patent Application; and
- (iii) together with all claims for damages by reason of present or future infringement of the Patents and any patent issued in respect of the Foreign Patent Application, with the right to sue for and collect the same for its own use and behalf, or for the use and behalf of its successors and assigns;

such Patents and Foreign Patent Application to be held and enjoyed by the **ASSIGNEE**, for **ASSIGNEE'S** own use and behalf, and

for ASSIGNEE'S successors and assigns, to the full end of the term or terms for which the Patents have been granted and the term or terms of any patent issued in respect of the Foreign Patent Application, as fully and entirely as the same would have been held by the ASSIGNOR had this sale, assignment, transfer and conveyance not been made; and, ASSIGNOR hereby covenants, agrees and undertakes at ASSIGNEE'S expense to execute, whenever requested by the ASSIGNEE, any further patent applications, assignments, lawful oaths and other papers which ASSIGNEE may deem necessary or desirable for securing to ASSIGNEE or for maintaining for ASSIGNEE the Patents and Foreign Patent Application hereby assigned. It is further understood and agreed that if additional country specific assignment documents and power of attorney forms are needed by ASSIGNEE to permit recordation of the transfers in various countries foreign to the United States, ASSIGNOR covenants, agrees and undertakes, at ASSIGNEE'S expense, to execute and return promptly all such documentation presented for execution as reasonably requested by Assignee;

ASSIGNOR represents and warrants that (i) it is the owner of the United States patents listed on Schedule A and the foreign patent application listed on Schedule B, (ii) it has all requisite corporate power and authority to sell, assign, transfer and convey the Patents and the Foreign Patent Application and (iii) no sale, assignment, agreement or encumbrance has been made or entered into by ASSIGNOR which would conflict with this Assignment. 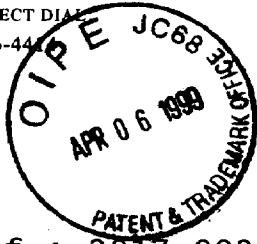
