ASSIGNMENT

WHEREAS, we, Robert J. Harrington, Bradley J. Hlista and Charles A. Wiley, citizens of the United States of America and residents of Austin, Texas, have invented certain new improvements in a "HIGH CONCURRENCY DATA DOWNLOAD APPARATUS AND METHOD," disclosed in an application for United States Letters Patent, said application having been filed on August 3, 1998, and assigned serial number 09/128,328.

WHEREAS, Instanton Corporation, a corporation of the State of Texas, having a place of business at 8920 Business Park Drive, Suite 10, Austin, Texas 78758 (hereinafter referred to as "ASSIGNEE"), is desirous of acquiring our entire right, title and interest in and to the invention, and in and to the said application and any Letters Patent that may issue thereon;

We hereby further agree that we will communicate to said ASSIGNEE, or to its successors, assigns and legal representatives, and facts known to us respecting any improvements; and, at the expense of said ASSIGNEE, to testify in any legal proceedings, sign all lawful papers, execute all divisional, continuation, continuation-in-part, reissue and substitute applications, and make all lawful oaths, and generally do everything possible to vest title in said ASSIGNEE and to aid said ASSIGNEE, its successors, assigns and legal representatives to obtain and enforce proper protection for said invention in all countries.




