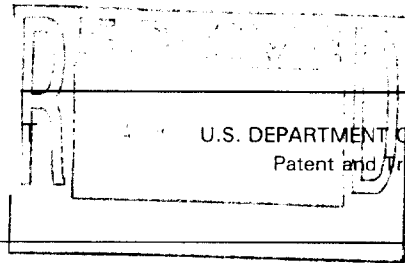

ASSIGNMENT


