ASSIGNMENT

We, Thomas L. Cable, residing in the City of Newbury, the County of Geauga, the State of Ohio; Adam B. Brakas, residing in the City of Chesterland, the County of Geauga, the State of Ohio; Robert C. Ruhl, residing in the City of Cleveland Heights, the County of Cuyahoga, the State of Ohio; and Christopher E. Milliken, residing in the City of South Euclid, the County of Cuyahoga, the State of Ohio, respectively, have invented certain new and useful improvements in METHOD FOR STEAM REFORMING HYDROCARBONS USING A SULFUR-TOLERANT CATALYST and Technology Management, Inc.
