WHEREAS, WE, PAUL SAGUES, a citizen of the United States, residing at 1 DeWitt Drive, Ross, California 94957, STEPHEN A. GAUDIO, a citizen of the United States, residing at 1908 Grant Street, Apt. C, Berkeley, California 94703 and TIM K. WONG, a citizen of the United States, residing at 3962 Fruitvale Avenue, Oakland, California 94602 have invented certain new and useful improvements in WAFER ALIGNER SYSTEM for which we have executed an application for Letters Patent of the United States of America of even date herewith; and

AND we hereby covenant that we have the full right to convey our entire interest herein assigned, and that we have not executed, and will not execute, any agreement in conflict therewith.






