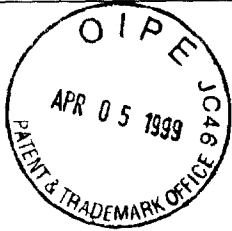



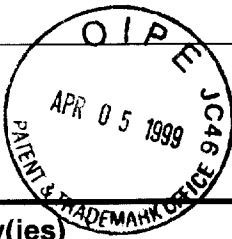

ASSIGNMENT AND AGREEMENT


For value received, we, Irwin Gerszberg, of Kendall Park in the County of Middlesex and State of New Jersey, Jeffrey S.
