**WHEREAS**, I am the sole inventor of certain new and useful improvements in **METHODS AND SYSTEMS FOR PROVIDING TEMPORARY IDENTIFICATION NUMBERS FOR MOBILE TERMINALS** for which an application for United States Letters Patent has been executed by me concurrently herewith, and
