






3. ROYALTY/LICENSE FEES





WHEREAS, DEROME is the inventor of certain "Inventions" relating to an Electrical Safety Plate, and has filed U.S. Patent Application Serial No. 09/019,937 directed at said Electrical Safety Plate

WHEREAS, NOVAK wishes to obtain a 50% interest in said Inventions relating to said Electrical Safety Plate, including a 50% interest in U.S. Patent Application Serial No. 09/019,937, including any and all foreign and counterpart applications;

WHEREAS DEROME is willing to grant to NOVAK said 50% interest in exchange for a one time payment of \$5,000.00

WHEREAS DEROME and NOVAK hereby wish to jointly exploit the Inventions relating to said Electrical Safety Plate, and to jointly share in any and all royalties, license fees, etc. which may be obtained for said Inventions;

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants herein contained, the parties do hereby agree as follows:

1. DEFINITIONS

Whenever used in this Agreement, the following terms shall have exclusively the meaning as defined hereafter:

1.1 "Inventions" shall mean and include an Electrical Safety Plate which contains a sliding receptor on an electrical plate for receiving a plug, which sliding receptor when disengaged positions itself to cover a standard household electrical outlet, as described and claimed in U.S. Patent Application Serial No. 09/019,837

1.2 "Assigned Patents" shall mean U.S. Patent Applications 09/019,837 and or like rights existing in any jurisdiction.

1.3 "Products" shall mean Electrical Plates sold which incorporate the Inventions and/or are made in accordance with any of the claims in any of the Assigned Patents and incorporating any Improvements thereto.

1.4 "Improvements" shall mean improvements to Inventions or Products, whether or not patentable, which, during the continuance of this Agreement are made, conceived or acquired by either party or by the parties jointly, or to which either party obtains rights which it can provide to the other without obligation to third parties, including changes made for purposes of improving the operation, efficiency or manufacturability of the Inventions or Products.

2. ASSIGNMENT

2.1 DEROME hereby agrees to assign to NOVAK, in exchange for payment of \$5000.00, which receipt is hereby acknowledged, subject to the terms, conditions and limitations hereafter stated, 50% of any and all rights in said Inventions and/or Products not previously assigned. In addition, DEROME hereby agrees to execute any and all necessary papers to be filed with the United States Patent Office to record the assignment herein.

2.2 DEROME may, but is not obligated to file additional patent applications or the like in any jurisdiction for any Inventions or any Improvements thereto not recited in U.S. Patent Application No. 09/019,837. DEROME shall pay all reasonable legal and filing fees for the preparation and prosecution of any such applications. Any patent or like right resulting from any such application, or any application pending on the date hereof shall be considered an Assigned Patent hereunder. In the event that DEROME elects not to file said patent applications, DEROME agrees to provide reasonable notice to NOVAK so that NOVAK can file such applications, at NOVAK's cost, and to cooperate with NOVAK to obtain said protection, and to grant NOVAK full ownership of said inventions and/or improvements.

3. ROYALTY/LICENSE FEES

3.1 DEROME and NOVAK hereby agree to jointly exploit the Inventions relating to said Electrical Safety Plate, and to jointly share in any and all royalties, license fees, or related financial gain which may be obtained for said Inventions, and to cooperate with one another in pursuit thereof.

4. DURATION AND TERMINATION

4.1 This Agreement shall come into force upon execution by both parties, and shall continue in full force and effect until the expiration of the last of any of the Assigned Patents, unless sooner terminated as hereinafter provided.

4.2 Each party hereto reserves the right of early termination in case of a material breach by the other party of one or more obligations hereunder, or in the case of bankruptcy or liquidation of either party.

5. INTEGRATION

5.1 The provision, terms and conditions of this Agreement represent the entire Agreement and understanding between the parties as to the subject matter hereof and supersede any prior discussions and negotiations between them, and neither of the parties shall be bound by any term, provision or condition, other than as expressly provided herein. Any modification of this Agreement shall be valid only if in writing and duly signed by both parties.

5.2 It is agreed that this Agreement shall be binding upon and inure to the benefit of the successors, assigns, heirs, executors, administrators and legal representatives of the parties.

5.3. Each party hereto acknowledges that it has consulted with his/her attorney prior to the signing of this Agreement.
