The ASSIGNOR, **Robert G. Marcotte** has invented certain new and useful improvements in:

AC PLASMA DISPLAY WITH APERTURED ELECTRODE PATTERNS

an invention which is fully described in an application for Letters Patent of the United States, executed on MAY 11, 1999.

The Assignor vests in Assignee like exclusive title in and to all such other applications and Letters Patent. The Assignor will execute and deliver to Assignee any documents which may be requested by Assignee to carry out the terms of this

Assignment.

The Commissioner of Patents of the United States is authorized and requested to issue Letters Patent of the United States to Assignee. The Assignor also authorizes and requests the equivalent authorities in foreign countries to issue the patents of foreign countries to Assignee.
