PATENT ASSIGNMENT


In consideration of One Dollar (\$1.00) and other valuable consideration paid, the receipt and legal sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged, Veris Industries, Inc., an Oregon corporation (the "Assignor") hereby sells, assigns, and transfers to Veris Industries LLC, a Delaware limited liability company, its successors, assigns, and legal representatives (collectively the "Assignee"), all of Assignor's right, title and interest in the United States of America and all foreign countries, in the United States Patents and Patent Applications listed on Schedule 1 hereto, and in and to such patents and applications and all divisional, continuing, continuation-in-part, improvements, extensions, substitute, renewal, reissue and all other applications for Letters Patent which have been or shall be filed on any of the inventions disclosed in those patents or applications in the United States of America and all foreign countries; and in and to all original and reissued patents which have been or shall be issued on such inventions in the United States of America and all foreign countries, including, without limitation, the right to apply for patent rights in each country and all rights to priority, and including all rights to sue and recover for past infringement of such patents, patent applications and the inventions disclosed therein.

Assignor agrees that Assignee may apply for and receive Letters Patent for such inventions in Assignee's own name and when requested, without charge to, but at the expense of Assignee, Assignor agrees promptly to carry out in good faith the intent and purpose of this Assignment by (i) executing, and agreeing to execute, all divisional, continuing, continuation-in-part, improvements, continuation patent application, substitute, renewal, reissue, and all other patent applications on any and all such inventions, (ii) by executing all rightful oaths, declarations, assignments, powers of attorney and other documents, (iii) by communicating to Assignee all facts known to Assignor relating to such inventions and the history thereof, and (iv) generally by doing everything possible which Assignee shall consider desirable for aiding in securing and maintaining proper patent protection for such inventions and for vesting title to such inventions and all applications for patents on such inventions in Assignee.

Assignor covenants with Assignee that no assignment, grant, mortgage, license or other agreement affecting the rights and property herein conveyed has been made to any third party by Assignor and that full right to convey the same as herein expressed is possessed by Assignor.
