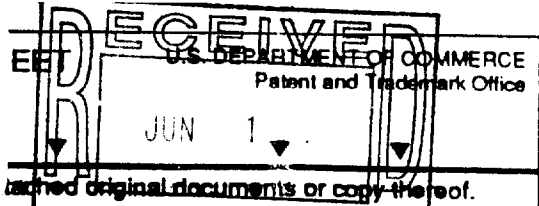

ASSIGNMENT

WHEREAS, we, Maynard E. Nelson, residing at post office address 160 S. Estates Dr., Salina, Kansas 67401; and Lowell L. Vonada, residing at post office address 126 West Park, Lincoln, Kansas 67455, having co-invented certain new and useful improvements in a MICROWAVE OVEN BAKER ASSEMBLY for which application for United States Letters Patent has been filed in the United States Patent Office having Serial No. 08/971,304, filing date November 17, 1997; and


WHEREAS, Lowell L. Vonada, its successors and assigns, and to obtain and enforce proper protection for said inventions in the United States and in any and all foreign countries.
