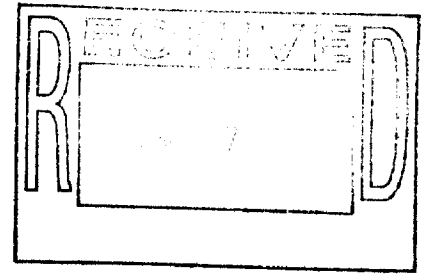

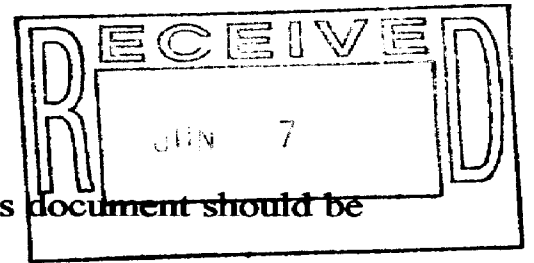



ASSIGNMENT

WHEREAS, I, John B. Rosen of Eugene, Oregon, have invented certain improvements in an AUTOMOTIVE DISPLAY UNIT ("the invention"), for which I have executed an application for United States Patent on March 26, 1999, and which was given U.S. Patent Application Serial No. 09/277,624.


