NUNC PRO TUNC ASSIGNMENT

WHEREAS, Philip W. Troyer, residing at 513 Redbud Lane, Middlebury, Indiana 46540, (hereinafter referred to as Assignor), has invented certain new and useful improvements in a VEHICLE PANEL for which an application for United States Letters Patent was executed on November 2, 1998.

WHEREAS, Coachmen Industries, Inc., a corporation of the state of Indiana, having a place of business at 601 East Beardsley Avenue, Elkhart, Indiana 46514 (hereinafter referred to as Assignee), is desirous of acquiring the entire right, title and interest in and to said invention and in and to any Letters Patent that may be granted therefor in the United States and in any and all foreign countries.

Assignor further acknowledges and authorizes that this assignment shall be nunc pro tunc and has the same legal force and effect as the assignment between Assignor and Assignee executed on October 29, 1998.

FURTHER, Assignor agrees to communicate to said Assignee or its representatives any facts known to Assignor respecting said invention, and testify in any legal proceeding, sign all lawful papers, execute all divisional, continuation, continuation-in-part, substitution, renewal, and reissue applications, execute all necessary assignment papers to cause any and all of said Letters Patent to be issued to said Assignee, make all rightful oaths and generally do everything possible to aid said Assignee, its successors and assigns, to obtain and enforce proper protection for said invention in the United States and in any and all foreign countries.
