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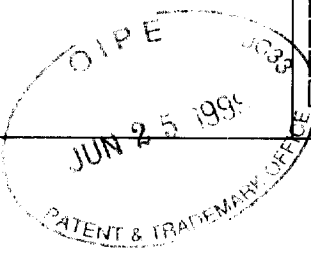

NOW, THEREFORE, for one dollar and other good and valuable consideration, the sufficiency and receipt of which are hereby acknowledged, I hereby assign and transfer to Pall Corporation and its legal representatives, successors and assigns my portion of the full and exclusive rights in and to said inventions and subject matter included in the above-mentioned patents in the U.S. and in each and every foreign country and my entire right, title, and interest in and to such patents, and any continuations, continuations-in-part, divisions, reissues, reexaminations or extensions thereof, and including priority rights and priority applications, as may have been or may be filed in the U.S. and foreign countries, and any patents as may have been or may be granted based thereon. I confirm that I have not previously assigned to any party any rights in the above-mentioned inventions or patents and that I am under no obligation to assign any rights in the same to any entity except for Pall Corporation, as stated above. I authorize Pall Corporation and its representatives to seek correction of the above-mentioned patents by adding my name as a co-inventor. I will, without further consideration, but at the expense of Pall Corporation, execute such additional writings and do such additional acts as may be necessary or desirable to perfect Pall Corporation's enjoyment of this assignment or to effectuate correction of the inventorship of the above-mentioned patents.
