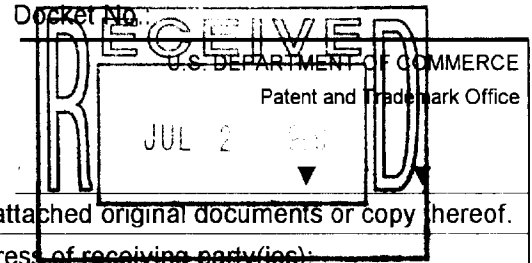

## ASSIGNMENT

This Assignment is made the 27<sup>th</sup> day of May, 1999, by Polymer Construction Products, Ltd. ("Assignor"), 14 East Windsor Terrace, Freehold, New Jersey 07728 to Charles Lee Thomason ("Assignee"), 60 West End Avenue, Shrewsbury, New Jersey 07702.

### RECITALS

WHEREAS, Assignor is the sole owner, by assignment, of the entire right, title and interest in and to U.S. Patent No. 5,626,807 (the "Patent") and the inventions claimed and described therein ("Inventions");

WHEREAS, Assignor desires to convey to Assignee an undivided 20% ownership of the right, title and interest in and to the Inventions and Patent in the United States of America and its territories and possessions, in all foreign countries, and in and to any United States or foreign Letters Patent that have been and may be granted therefor, and in and to such other forms of protection of industrial property as have been and may be granted therefor pursuant to the laws of any country:

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of \$1.00, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, Assignor does hereby assign, transfer, and convey unto Assignee, an undivided 20% ownership of the right, title and interest in the United States of America and its territories and possessions and in all foreign countries in and to (a) the Inventions; (b) the Patent; (c) all divisional, continuing, substitute, continuation-in-part, extension, reissue and other patent applications and applications for any other form of industrial property protection applicable thereto; (d) the right

to sue and obtain damages for past infringement of the Patent and any foreign Letters Patent and other forms of protection of industrial property as have been granted for the Inventions; and (e) any and all Letters Patent or other form of industrial property protection relating to the Inventions now or hereafter granted by the United States or any foreign countries, to be held and enjoyed by the Assignee to the full end of the term or terms for which said Patent, Letters Patent, or any other form of industrial property protection have been or may be granted, as fully and entirely as the same would have been held and enjoyed by Assignor, had this assignment not been made.

Assignor covenants to take all other actions and to execute and deliver all additional instruments and documents, which the Assignee may deem necessary or desirable to make this Assignment fully effective and to enable Assignee to enjoy to the fullest extent the rights, title and interests herein conveyed in the United States and foreign countries.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, Assignor has executed this instrument as of the date indicated above.


