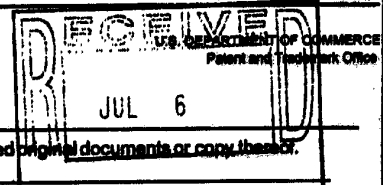

ASSIGNMENT
