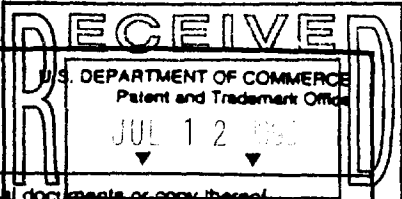

ASSIGNMENT
