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
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
We, Catherine Jean Randall, Matthew Todd Hupp and Jennifer Kay Kerfoot (addresses shown below), have made a certain new, and useful invention as set forth in an application for United States Letters Patent entitled STACKABLE, SELF-SUPPORTING CONTAINER WITH SLIDING MECHANICAL CLOSURE, Attorney's Docket 7527, Serial No. 09/296,815, filed the 22nd day of April, 1999, (the hereinafter named assignee being hereby authorized to insert said US Serial Number or Number of International Application designating the US and filing date when ascertained):
