**DISCLAIMER AND QUITCLAIM**

WHEREAS, BI Incorporated, a Colorado corporation, located at 6400 Lookout Road, Boulder, Colorado 80301 (hereinafter "BI"), now owns by assignment from CAE Electronics, Inc., as recorded on March 24, 1997, in the records of the U.S. Patent and Trademark Office at Reel 331 8430 and Frame 0815, the entire right, title, and interest in and to a certain invention entitled CELLULAR POSITION LOCATING SYSTEM, for which Letters Patent of the United States, Patent No. 5,043,736, was issued on August 27, 1991, and for which a reexamination certificate no. BI 5,043,736 was issued on September 6, 1994;

WHEREAS, Hughes Electronics Corporation (hereinafter "Hughes") recorded an Intellectual Property Assignment in the records of the U.S. Patent and Trademark Office on April 30, 1998, at Reel 9342, Frames 0796-0812, which Intellectual Property Assignment, dated the 17th day of December 1997, purported, *inter alia*, to transfer U.S. Patent No. 5,043,736 from HE Holdings, Inc., to Hughes;

WHEREAS, neither HE Holdings, Inc., nor Hughes ever owned or held any title or interest in or to U.S. Patent No. 5,043,736, and inclusion of this U.S. Patent No. 5,043,736 in the list of patents transferred by that Intellectual Property Assignment from HE Holdings, Inc., to Hughes was an error made without any deceptive intent; and

WHEREAS, Hughes has been made aware of the error based on documents provided by BI and wishes to remove any cloud or uncertainty in the record relating to BI's ownership of U.S. Patent No. 5,043,736;

NOW THEREFORE, be it known that for and in consideration of the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00) and certain other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged, Hughes, by these presents does disclaim any right, title, and interest in and to U.S. Patent No. 5,043,736, and does also quitclaim unto the said BI, its successors, legal

representatives, and assigns, any and all of its right, title, and interest, if any, in and to the said invention and aforesaid U.S. Patent No. 5,043,736 for the territory of the United States of America and for all foreign countries and to all Letters Patent, continuations, divisionals, reissues, and extensions to be obtained therefor, including any right Hughes may have or had to sue for infringements; and Hughes further agrees to cooperate with BI hereafter in obtaining, sustaining, and enforcing any and all such Letters Patent, but at the expense of BI, including executing all appropriate documents as necessary.

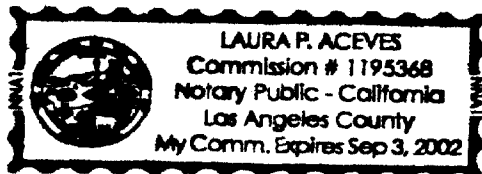
