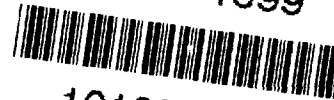
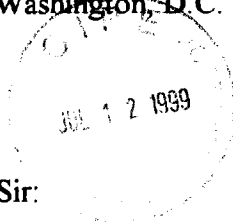

## ASSIGNMENT

WHEREAS, ANTHONY LAU, a resident of Los Altos, California, and DAN ION HARITON, a resident of Pinole, California, hereinafter referred to as "Assignors," have invented certain new and useful improvements as described and set forth in an application for Letters Patent of the United States entitled "BIST FOR TESTING A CURRENT-VOLTAGE CONVERSION AMPLIFIER" filed with the U.S. Patent Office on April 19, 1999, under Serial No. 09/294,235;


