

ASSIGNMENT

WHEREAS, Matthew D. Pope of 5845 South Danube Circle, Aurora, Colorado, 80015, has invented certain new and useful improvements in OSCILLATOR WITH POWER CONSERVATION MODE, for which he has made application for Letters Patent of the United States of America, said application being identified as Docket No. 1320, and executed concurrently herewith, and;
