

JOINT

THIS ASSIGNMENT, by Brian J. Bellhouse, Charles D.O. Potter and John C. Greenford (hereinafter referred to as the assignors), residing at Islip, Oxfordshire; Standlake, Oxon; and Abingdon, Oxfordshire, respectively, witnesseth:

WHEREAS, the said assignors have invented certain new and useful improvements in PARTICLE DELIVERY set forth in an application for Letters Patent of the United States, bearing Serial No. 09/156,421 and filed on 18 September 1998; and

WHEREAS, PowderJect Research Limited, a company organized and existing under the laws of England and Wales, of 4 Robert Robinson Avenue, The Oxford Science park, Oxford OX4 4GA, United Kingdom (hereinafter referred to as the assignee) is desirous of acquiring the entire right, title and interest in and to said inventions and said application for Letters Patent of the United States, and in and to any Letters Patent or Patents, United States or foreign, to be obtained therefor and thereon:

AND for the same consideration, the said assignors hereby covenant and agree to and with the said assignee, its successors, legal representatives and assigns, that, at the time of execution and delivery of these presents, the said assignors are the sole and lawful owners of the entire right, title and interest in and to the said inventions and the application for Letters Patent above-mentioned, and that the same are unencumbered and that the said assignors have good and full right and lawful authority to sell and convey the same in the manner herein set forth.

division, continuation or continuation-in-part of any application for Letters Patent or any reissue or extension of any Letters Patent, to be obtained thereon, is lawful and desirable, sign all papers and documents, take all lawful oaths, and do all acts necessary or required to be done for the procurement, maintenance, enforcement and defense of Letters Patent for said inventions, without charge to said assignee, its successors, legal representatives and assigns, but at the cost and expense of the said assignee, its successors, legal representatives and assigns.
