Whereas, we, JAYANT S. LODAYA, RAYMOND A. LOHR, JR., and DONALD L. FIELDS, JR. and have invented certain new and useful improvements in the PREPARATION OF QUINONEDIIMINES FROM PHENYLENEDIAMINES USING OXYGEN AND A METAL OR METAL SALT CATALYST, which an application for United States Letters Patent has been executed; and
