WHEREAS, **Masakazu YAMAGATA, Shunichiro WAKAMIYA, Tatsuo GOTOH, Homu TAKAYAMA and Yoichi KOJIMA**, all citizens of Japan having post office addresses are c/o **Asahi Seimitsu Kabushiki Kaisha**, 5-2, Higashioizumi 2-chome, Nerima-ku, Tokyo, Japan, hereinafter referred to as the ASSIGNORS, have invented a certain improvement relating to

OPTICAL AXIS CORRECTING SYSTEM

AND said ASSIGNORS authorize and request the Commissioner of Patents to issue Letters Patent on said application, and on any and all divisions and continuations thereof, to said ASSIGNEE, its assigns and legal representatives, in accordance herewith.
