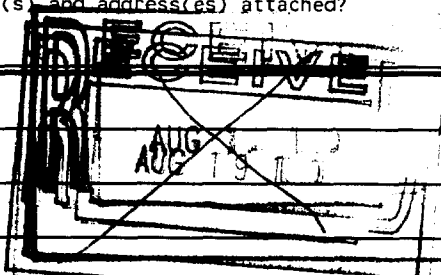

ASSIGNMENT
