ASSIGNMENT

The ASSIGNOR, Matsushita Electronics Corporation, a Japanese corporation having its principal office at 1-1 Saiwai-cho, Takatsuki, Osaka 569-1193 Japan, by virtue of an assignment from Plasmaco, Inc., owns full right and title to an invention entitled:

invented by Robert G. Marcotte, an invention which is fully described in an application executed by him on May 11, 1999, for Letters Patent of the United States.

The Assignor further agrees, for itself and its legal representatives, that it will assist Assignee in the prosecution before the United States Patent Office and the Federal Courts of this application, and other applications for Letters Patent including renewals, continuations, divisions, reissues and substitutions, that the Assignee elects to make covering the

invention. The Assignor vests in Assignee like exclusive title in and to all such other applications and Letters Patent. The Assignor will execute and deliver to Assignee any documents which may be requested by Assignee to carry out the terms of this Assignment.

The Commissioner of Patents of the United States is authorized and requested to issue Letters Patent of the United States to Assignee. The Assignor also authorizes and requests the equivalent authorities in foreign countries to issue the patents of foreign countries to Assignee.
