IN UNITED STATES PATENTS**

FOR GOOD AND VALUABLE CONSIDERATION, receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, Donnelley Marketing, Inc., a Delaware corporation (the "Grantor") with principal offices at 1717 Park Street, Naperville, Illinois, hereby grants to Bankers Trust Company, as Collateral Agent, with principal offices at One Bankers Trust Plaza, 130 Liberty Street, New York, New York 10006 (the "Grantee"), a security interest in (i) all of the Grantor's right, title and interest in and to the United States patents and patent applications (the "Patents") set forth on Schedule A attached hereto, together with (ii) all Proceeds (as such term is defined in the Security Agreement referred to below) and products of the Patents, (iii) the goodwill of the businesses with which the Patents are associated and (iv) all causes of action arising prior to or after the date hereof for infringement of any of the Patents or unfair competition regarding the same.




Grant are deemed to conflict with the Security Agreement, the provisions of the Security Agreement shall govern.
