

1. Assignor declares and agrees that as used in this Assignment of Inventions, Applications and Patents ("Assignment") the following terms have the following meaning:
 - A. "Applications" means (i) the Application for United States Patent, including the right to claim priority of the filing date in connection with the Applications in all countries other than the country in which the Original Application is filed ("Original Application"), and any and all letters patent issued in connection with the Original Application ("Letters Patent"), (ii) any and all direct and indirect divisions, continuations and continuations-in-part of the Original Application and any Letters Patent, (iii) any and all reissues or extensions of Letters Patent, (iv) any and all rights under any international treaties and conventions, including without limitation the International Convention for the Protection of Industrial Property, (v) any and all applications for a patent or patents filed in countries other than the United States ("Foreign Countries"), and (vi) any and all patents which issue in connection with the Invention and the Original Application, for the full end of the term for which the Applications, Letters Patent, and related property rights may be granted;
 - B. "Assignor" means Kenneth Tuross;
 - C. "Assignee" means Sun Standard, Inc., a New Mexico corporation, including (i) any and all subsidiaries, affiliates and controlled companies of Assignee, and (ii) any and all successors, assigns and legal representatives of Assignee;

7. Assignor, for the same consideration, represents and warrants to Assignee, and to

the Assignee's successors, assigns, and legal representatives, that at the time of execution and delivery of this Assignment and these presents, except for any rights, titles and interests that have arisen to Assignee under law or that have already been transferred to Assignee, Assignor is the lawful owner of the entire right, title and interest in and to the Invention and Original Application, that the entire right, title and interest in and to the Invention and Original Application are unencumbered, and that Assignor has good and full right and lawful authority to assign, sell and convey the entire right, title and interest in and to the Invention and Original Application as provided in this Assignment.


