ASSIGNMENT OF U.S. Patent No. 5,806,071 for RECORDING with the PATENT OFFICE

SECTION 1 Background

InfoAmerica, Inc. with principal office at 2600 Canton Court, Suite G, Fort Collins, Colorado 80525 (hereinafter "Original Owner") fully owns all right, title, and interest in United States Letters Patent No. 5,806,071, granted 8 September 1998, and a foreign counterpart patent application currently pending in the Canadian Patent Office, with the following title:

**Process and System for Configuring Information for
Presentation at an Interactive Electronic Device.**

Pursuant to a **MERGER AGREEMENT AND PLAN of REORGANIZATION** ("MERGER AGREEMENT") the Original Owner has formed and duly registered a wholly-owned subsidiary corporation named **InfoAmerica/USA, Inc.** with offices at 2600 Canton Court, Suite G, Fort Collins, Colorado 80525 ("InfoAmerica/USA"). (2) all United States and foreign applications that have been, and may hereafter be, filed therefor including but not limited to divisional, continuation, continuation-in-part, reissue, or reexamination applications, *as well as*

(3) any additional Letters Patent which issue in the United States or elsewhere including but not limited to: utility, utility model, or design patents; patents of implementation, improvement, or addition; inventor's certificates; and extensions of any of these

so that said right, title, and interest is held and enjoyed by InfoAmerica/USA, its successors and assigns, as fully and entirely as it would have been held and enjoyed by Original Owner had this Assignment and sale not been made.

The Original Owner hereby agrees to fully execute all documents or papers necessary for effecting the transfer made herein, and for obtaining additional Letters Patent in the United States and elsewhere, and to furnish all data, information, and documentation which may be required for the preparation, filing, and prosecution of applications for said additional Letters Patent.

The U.S. Commissioner of Patents is hereby directed to record the assignment of U.S. Patent No. 5,806,071 to InfoAmerica/USA, Inc. in accordance with the terms of this Assignment.
