ASSIGNMENT

WHEREAS, we, Thomas M. Luebke of Menomonee Falls, Wisconsin, and David L. Wiesemann of Pewaukee, Wisconsin, have made certain inventions which are described in an application for Letters Patent of the United States entitled ELECTRICAL INSTRUMENT, filed March 1, 1999, and assigned Application No. 29/101,238, and

We hereby warrant that we have the full right to make the conveyance herein, and we hereby covenant that we, our heirs, legal representatives and assigns, will, when requested, communicate to said Company, its representatives, successors and assigns, all facts known respecting said inventions, execute all divisional, continuing, reissue, reexamination and foreign applications together with individual assignments therefor, make all rightful oaths, sign all lawful papers, testify in any legal proceeding and generally do everything possible to aid said Company, its successors and assigns, in the obtaining of Letters Patent.
