PATENT ASSIGNMENT AGREEMENT

This Patent Assignment Agreement (the "Agreement") is entered into by and between VisPro Corporation, an Oregon corporation with offices in Beaverton, Oregon, ("VisPro") and Tektronix, Inc., an Oregon corporation with offices in Wilsonville, Oregon, ("Tektronix").

A. Tektronix is the owner by assignment of United States Patent Number 5,068,210, issued November 26, 1991, in the names of John F. DiLazzaro, James L. McAlpin, and Joanne R. Mark for "Low Dielectric Constant Ceramic Materials" (the "-210 Patent");

B. In an Asset Purchase Agreement dated January 26, 1994, between the parties, Tektronix granted VisPro a non-exclusive, royalty-free license under the -210 Patent and agreed to transfer ownership of the patent to VisPro if Tektronix elected not to maintain it, *provided*, however, that in such event Tektronix would have all the license rights granted to VisPro under the terms of the Asset Purchase Agreement.

C. Tektronix has elected not to maintain the -210 Patent, and VisPro desires to receive an assignment of the patent.

In consideration of the premises and the mutual covenants contained herein, the parties agree as follows:

1. Tektronix hereby assigns and agrees to assign its entire right, title, and interest in and to the -210 Patent to VisPro per the appended Patent Assignment.


2. VisPro hereby grants and agrees to grant Tektronix a perpetual, non-exclusive, non-transferable, royalty-free, world-wide license under the -210 Patent to make, use and sell all products that are covered by, the subject of, or result from the use of the -210 Patent.

3. Each party shall bear its own attorney fees and costs related to this transaction.

4. The parties agree to execute such further documents, agreements, or consents as may be required to effectuate this Agreement.

5. The effective date of this Agreement shall be latter execution date set out below.




PATENT ASSIGNMENT
