

ASSIGNMENT OF PATENTS AND PATENT APPLICATIONS

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Purchase Agreement, Assignor desires to assign and Assignee desires to acquire all right, title and interest in and to said patents and patent applications; and

NOW THEREFORE, for good and valuable consideration, which Assignor acknowledges is sufficient and has been received, Assignor does hereby SELL, ASSIGN AND TRANSFER to Assignee and Assignee's successors and assigns the entire right, title and interest of Assignor in and to the United States patents and pending applications for United States patents described on attached Schedule A, the invention or inventions covered thereby, any and all patents which may be granted for said inventions in the United States and any countries throughout the world, including the right to claim priority from the applications as provided by the Paris Convention and the right to recover for any and all past infringements. Assignor hereby authorizes and requests the Commissioner of Patents and Trademarks to issue all letters patent on said inventions to Assignee.

The right, title and interest is to be held and enjoyed by Assignee and Assignee's successors and assigns as fully and exclusively as it would have been held and enjoyed by Assignor had this assignment not been made, for the full term of any letters patent and registrations which have been or may be granted thereon, or of any division, renewal, continuation in whole or in part, substitution, conversion, reissue, prolongation or extension thereof.

Assignor further agrees that it will, without charge to Assignee, but at Assignee's expense, (i) cooperate with Assignee in the prosecution of United States patent applications and foreign counterparts on the invention(s) covered by this Assignment and any improvements thereto, (ii) execute, verify, acknowledge and deliver all such further instruments and papers, including patent applications and instruments of transfer, and (iii) perform such other acts as Assignee lawfully and reasonably may request to obtain or maintain letters patent and registrations for the invention(s) covered by this Assignment and any improvements thereto in any and all countries and to vest title thereto in Assignee or Assignee's successors and assigns.

This Assignment is given pursuant to the Purchase Agreement. Nothing contained in this Assignment shall be deemed to supersede, enlarge on or modify any of the obligations,

agreements, covenants, or warranties of Assignor or Assignee contained in the Purchase Agreement, all of which survive the execution and delivery of this Assignment.

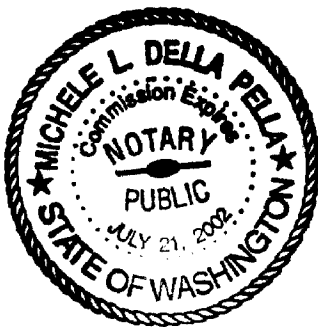
