ASSIGNMENT

WHEREAS, O.F. Mossberg & Sons, Inc., a Connecticut corporation having a principal place of business at 7 Grasso Avenue, North Haven, Connecticut 06473 (hereinafter "MOSSBERG") is the owner of the inventions and discoveries disclosed in U.S. Patent Application Serial No. 09/121,926 for "Inertial Cycling System for Firearms" and U.S. Patent Application Serial No. 09/122,406, now U.S. Patent No. 5,941,005 issued August 24, 1999 for "Safety and Bolt Assembly System for Firearms" (hereinafter collectively referred to as the "PATENT APPLICATIONS");

WHEREAS, the following entities have previously assigned to MOSSBERG, as indicated by short-form Assignments executed on December 1, 1998, all their rights, titles and interests in the aforementioned inventions, discoveries, and PATENT and PATENT APPLICATIONS: Vincent P. Battaglia, an individual residing at 91 Kenwood Avenue, Fairfield, Connecticut 06430 (hereinafter "BATTAGLIA"); Vincent P. Battaglia, LLC, d.b.a. Battaglia Engineering, a Connecticut Corporation having a principal place of business at 91 Kenwood Avenue, Fairfield, Connecticut 06430 (hereinafter "BATTAGLIA ENGINEERING"); and BML Tool & Manufacturing Company (a.k.a. BML Tool & Manufacturing Corporation), a Connecticut corporation having a principal place of business at 91 Kenwood Avenue, Fairfield, Connecticut 06430 (hereinafter "BML TOOL");

WHEREAS, the aforementioned Assignments have been recorded in the Assignment Division in the U.S. Patent and Trademark Office, at the following Reels/Frames: 9701/0389; 9701/0808; 9708/0712; and 9721/0211;

WHEREAS, BATTAGLIA wishes to "re-acquire" from MOSSBERG all of those rights, titles and interests previously assigned by BATTAGLIA, BATTAGLIA ENGINEERING and BML TOOL, and MOSSBERG is willing to transfer or "re-assign" those rights to BATTAGLIA; and

WHEREAS, BATTAGLIA, BATTAGLIA ENGINEERING, BML TOOL, and MOSSBERG, previously entered into a long-form Assignment Agreement on July 16, 1998 (hereinafter "ASSIGNMENT AGREEMENT");

NOW THEREFORE, MOSSBERG acknowledges as follows:

1. The ASSIGNMENT AGREEMENT is hereby terminated pursuant to paragraph 7.3.
2. MOSSBERG hereby assigns, transfers and conveys to BATTAGLIA its rights, titles and interests in the aforementioned inventions and discoveries, and PATENT APPLICATIONS, to the extent contained within the aforementioned recorded Assignments.
3. MOSSBERG hereby warrants that MOSSBERG has not knowingly conveyed to others any right in the inventions, discoveries, and PATENT APPLICATIONS, or any license to use the same or to make, use or sell anything embodied or utilizing any of said inventions or discoveries; and that MOSSBERG has good right to make the indicated assignment without encumbrance.
