



representatives, to obtain and enforce proper protection for said invention in all countries.

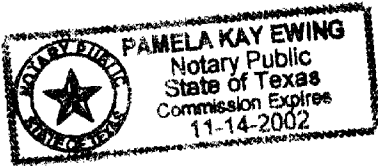
